3. The horse being transferred will be taken on a 6-month trial basis.
4. The horse may be returned at any point to Pal-O-Mine Equestrian for no charge.
5. The new owner agrees to the utmost highest standard of care for the horse.
6. The new horse owner acknowledges having prior horse owning experience, and that the horse will be kept at a facility with other horses.
7. The new owner acknowledges that a site visit will be conducted prior to transfer of ownership, that updates on the horse's care will be provided for 1 year, and unannounced visits can be made to assure the quality of care for the horse during that period.
8. The horse being transferred will not be bred.
9. The horse being transferred will not be adopted, rehomed or sold without written consent and approval by Pal-O-Mine Equestrian, and notification must be made prior to entering an adoption/re-homing/sales agreement.
10. Any individual or organization in possession of the equine as of the date of the agreement and any time thereafter is bound to not sell the equine at auction for slaughter or allow the equine to be sold, transferred, released, or otherwise placed into possession of any person or organization that will cause or allow the equine to be sold at auction for slaughter.
11. Prior to transfer of ownership to _____, references from the new owner's Veterinarian, Farrier, and 2 Personal References will be required to be submitted and approved.
12. Any breach of this agreement will require the horse to be returned to the care of Pal-O-Mine Equestrian.
