

Transfer of Ownership

SE warrants that Special Equestrians has clear title to ______("Horse"). Horse is transferred as is and with all faults. SE makes no warranties express or implied including that SE makes no warranty of fitness for any particular purpose. Adopter has had the right toan independent veterinary pre-purchase examination. Adopter assumes all risks of ownership as of ____DATE____.

SE reserves the right of first refusal in the event that the Horse is to be sold, leased, or given away by the Adopter or removed from the Adopter's custody and care. Adopter must contact SE if considering transferring the Horse to another person's custody and care. Should the adopter decide to re-home the equine, SE must be notified of the name, address, and telephone number of any individual or organization intending to take possession of the equine for any reason prior to the equine being placed into the possession of such individual or organization as of the date of this agreement and any time thereafter.

Any individual or organization in possession of the equine as of the date of the agreement and any time thereafter <u>is bound to not sell the equine at auction for</u> <u>slaughter</u> or allow the equine to be sold, transferred, released, or otherwise placed into possession of any person or organization that will cause or allow the equine to be sold at auction for slaughter.

Adopter is responsible for transporting the Horse from SE.
