



Transfer of Ownership / Re-Homing Agreement

This agreement is made on this ____ day of _____, _____ between the National Center for Equine Facilitated Therapy (NCEFT), hereinafter referred to as "TRANSFEROR" and _____, hereinafter referred to as " TRANSFEREE ".

This agreement is effective as of this _____ day of _____, _____ and is entered into between TRANSFEROR and TRANSFEREE for the transfer of ownership of the equine described below on the following terms and conditions:

A. RIGHTS AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

1. TRANSFEROR hereby relinquishes and transfers all ownership rights and responsibilities of the aforementioned equine to TRANSFEREE.
2. TRANSFEREE agrees to make the best effort to keep said equine in good health and free from disease by providing adequate feed, shelter, veterinary, and farrier care.
3. TRANSFEREE shall assume all expenses related to the care of said equine, including all expenses related to any accident, illness, or other peril that may occur including death or permanent disability of equine.
4. TRANSFEREE as of the date of the agreement and any time thereafter is bound to not sell the equine at auction for slaughter or allow the equine to be sold, transferred, released, or otherwise placed into possession of any person or organization that will cause or allow the equine to be sold at auction for slaughter.
5. If TRANSFEREE should at any time in the future decided to relinquish ownership to said equine, the TRANSFEROR will be the first to be notified and will be given the first right of refusal.
6. If TRANSFEREE decides to re-home the equine, TRANSFEROR must grant approval of any individual or organization intending to take possession of the equine for any reason prior to the equine being placed into the possession of such individual or organization, including being provided written notification of the name, address, and telephone number of any individual or organization intending to take possession of the equine for any reason.
7. TRANSFEROR reserves the right to make scheduled visits.
8. If there is any breach to this contract, the equine must be returned to TRANSFEROR.
9. This agreement is binding on any future individual or organization taking and/or in possession of the equine for any reason.
