- Adopter agrees to be legally and financially responsible for providing proper care for Equine.
- Adopter agrees to be responsible, as provided by state law, for any personal injury, property damage, or death caused by Equine in their care.
- Adopter shall not breed Equine.
- Adopter agrees that Owner shall be granted the right go make scheduled visits.
- Adopter agrees to immediately notify Owner in writing if they can no longer care for Equine and wish to return it to Owner.
- Adopter agrees that if Adopter ever chooses to sell, transfer, or giveaway said Equine, Adopter will provide Owner with the first right of refusal to re-possess or purchase the previously adopted Equine at a fair amount to be negotiated between both parties but not to exceed the amount of adoption donation under this agreement.
- Adopter agrees that Equine cannot be sold, adopted or given away without prior written approval from Owner.

- Adopter agrees that should the Adopter decide to re-home the Equine, the organization must be notified of the name, address and telephone number of any individual or organization intending to take possession of the Equine for any reason prior to the Equine being placed into the possession of such individual as of the date of this agreement and any time thereafter.
- Adopter shall not treat Equine inhumanely according to Pennsylvania state laws.
- Adopter shall not destroy Equine, or have Equine destroyed, except as an act of mercy, and under attention and advice of licensed veterinarian.
- Adopter and Owner recognize that any individual or organization in possession of the Equine as of the date of the agreement and any time thereafter are bound to not sell the Equine at auction for slaughter or allow the Equine to be sold, transferred, released or otherwise placed into the possessions of any person or organization that will cause of allow the equine to be sold at auction for slaughter.
- Adopter agrees that should Adopter violates and terms of this agreement that Adopter shall return Equine to Owner.
- Terms of the agreement are binding on any future adopter or any third-party person or entity taking possession of the equine and that the agreement must be incorporated as an addendum to any future agreement.
- Terms of the agreement are binding on any future adopter or any third-party person or entity taking possession of the equine and that any future adopter or any third-party person or entity taking possession of the equine must re-sign an agreement with the organization prior to the equine being placed into the possession of any future adopter or any third-party person or entity.
