Potential adopters/purchasers are encouraged to do a short-term, on-site foster

• ADDITIONALLY:

- O Any individual or organization in possession of the equine as of the date of the agreement and any time thereafter is bound to not sell the equine at auction for slaughter or allow the equine to be sold, transferred, released, or otherwise placed into possession of any person or organization that will cause or allow the equine to be sold at auction for slaughter.
- The re-homed equine CANNOT be sold, adopted, transferred, auctioned, released, given away, or otherwise placed into the possession of another individual or organization <u>under any circumstances</u> and must be returned to KFTHC should the adopter decide that he/she is no longer able, or no longer wishes, to care for the equine.
- o Adopters/purchasers can return an equine to KFTHC free of charge.
- KFTHC will accept financial responsibility for equines in the current care of KFTHC that need to be retired or are no longer able to contribute to the mission of the organization.

I understand and will comply with KFTHC'S POLICIES AND PROCEDURES AS STATED IN THE REHOMING/ADOPTION POLICIES AND CONTRACT:

IF THERE IS ANY BREACH OF CONTRACT THE EQUINE MUST IMMEDIATELY BE RETURNED TO KETHC.
